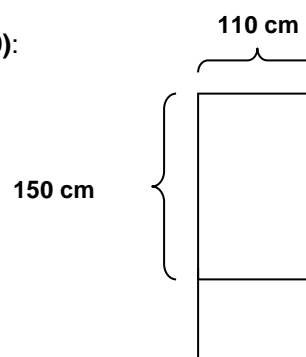

Presenters are requested to stand by their poster during the presentation time as per above table.

- Maximum poster measurements (**VERTICAL PRESENTATION DIN A0**):

Width 110 cm (43.31 inches)
Height 150 cm (59.06 inches)

- We suggest designing your poster in the following sections:
 - ❖ Title, author(s), address... (on the upper edge, across the width of the whole poster)
 - ❖ Introduction
 - ❖ Methods
 - ❖ Results
 - ❖ Conclusions



- **Disclosure** of conflict of interest (e.g. grant support, consultancy, membership on advisory councils, speaker's bureau) and source of funding **is mandatory**. Please prepare **for each listed author** a one sentence statement to this effect.
- The **title** should be emphasised by the use of a bold type face. This writing should be easily readable at a distance of 2 – 3 meters. The text can be broken up by the inclusion of drawings, charts and/or photos.
- To promote your work you may like to bring handouts for distribution to interested delegates.
- Poster numbers will be provided and fixed to each poster wall. Your poster number can be found on the congress website www.chest-sgp-switzerland2017.org under "Scientific Program" at the end of March 2017. Material to affix the posters will be provided.
- Please strictly adhere to the mounting and removal times. If the poster has not been removed by the end of the allocated removal time, it will be disposed of by congress staff.
- Publication: All accepted abstracts be published as a joint publication in the Journals *Respiration* (SGP) and *CHEST* as well as on the website of the Joint CHEST-SGP 2017 one week prior to the congress.
